INFORMATION AND SCHEDULE

Venue: Cherry High School 3943 Tamminen Rd, Cherry. MN

Captains: Team captains are responsible for all event information. <u>See schedule for</u>

<u>quick review meeting times and location.</u> Teams are to report to their assigned court **no later than 25 minutes** prior to the 1st Match start time.

Note: Teams that play or ref in the second round of the pool play are not required to attend the

quick review meeting. Simply check in with our tournament manager.

Format: Pool play followed by upper and lower division playoffs.

Pool Play: Four Team Pool Match Play: 2 sets to 25, capped at 26.

Three Team Pool Match Play: 3 sets to 25, capped at 26.

Teams do not switch court sides!

Coin Toss: No Coin toss!

The team (A, B, C, D) listed first (considered home team) on the pool schedule will serve first in set 1 and set 3. the team listed second will serve first in set

number two.

Playoffs: Matches will be best of 3 sets to 25, must win by 2. Tie breaker third set

played to 15. Teams in the upper part of the bracket will be (considered the

home team) serve first in set number 1 and set 3 if necessary.

Tie Breaker: Two-way ties are decided based on head-to-head results. Three-way ties are

decided by total plus-minus of all pool play sets. If still tied revert to head-to-

head competition.

Officiating / Rules:

High School rules will apply with the following modifications:

- 1. Matches will be officiated by non-playing teams. (**Team in parenthesis on the schedule**) Teams must provide an R1, R2, scorekeeper and flip scorer. Playing teams will provide one line judge each.
- 2. **No line up checks** will be conducted. Starting players just take the court.
- 3. **Substitution** Just simply sub in and out. No formality required.
- 4. Teams will not switch sides during the match.

5. Teams will shake hands at the end of the match only.

Balls: Teams must supply their own balls for warm-ups and matches.

Uniforms: Uniforms <u>are not</u> required. Libero must wear a contrasting shirt color.

Team Areas: Teams will be allowed to camp in open areas in the gym. Please keep the

gym clean and throw away your garbage.

Spectator / Admissions Fee: \$8.00 Adult, \$5.00 Student

Concessions / Food Policy: Concessions will be available.

Travel Difficulties: If your team experiences travel difficulties and will not be able to arrive on
