VENUES:	Virginia High School Hibbing High School
EVENT INFORMATION:	Team reps and coaches are responsible for all event information and procedures. <ul style="list-style-type: none">• Teams are to report to their assigned court no later than 25 minutes prior to the 1st Match start time.• The event manager (EM) will conduct a quick review meeting. See page 2 for time and location.• Teams that are scheduled to play the 2nd match of pool play do not need to attend the quick review meeting, but must check in with the Event Manager upon arrival.
TIME LIMITS:	Time limits on match play will only be used if necessary.
TEAM BENCHES:	Only team representatives (Coach, Player, Manager) may be seated at the team bench.
COURT SIDE READINESS:	The on-deck team. Teams that play or officiate in a succeeding match must be at courtside mid-way through the second / third set of the current match.
PROTOCOL:	There will be no pre-match protocol of teams taking the end line and proceeding to shake hands at the net. After warm-up periods teams simply take on court playing positions. After the match teams will shake hands.
OFFICIATING:	North Country Region (NCR) officiating requirements will apply for all divisions except 12 and under. <ul style="list-style-type: none">• Seven person officiating team. R1, R2, L1, L2, Scorekeeper, Timekeeper and Libero Tracker.• Only assigned officials are allowed at the scorekeeper's table. Adult supervision is recommended.• No Electronic Devices or cell phones are allowed at the scorekeeper's table, unless used for timing purposes.
DEAD BALL HUSTLE:	(DBH) Players hustle the ball when it is dead or out of bounds. Get the ball to the server as quick as possible.
BALLS:	Teams must provide balls for warm-ups and match play.
12'S PLAYING MODIFICATIONS:	See Page Five. <u>Scheduled officiating teams responsible for score board flipping and score sheet ticking.</u>
TEAM CAMP AREAS:	Teams <u>must</u> clean their camp area before leaving the facility. (See host for camp areas.)
SPECTATOR SEATING:	Will be designated by host.
FOOD POLICY:	Teams are prohibited from eating in the gym. Water bottles only. <u>Coolers are not allowed in buildings.</u>
POOL PLAY DEFAULT:	If a team does not show as scheduled, the pool will be re-formatted (defaulted) to a 5, 4, or 3 team pool. If revisions need to be made the day of play, pools will then default to the appropriate pool play schedule.

In the spirit of sportsmanship, it is suggested that the non-warm-up team shag balls for the hitting team.

Main Points to Remember for Playing Efficiency:

1. The team that served first in set one will serve first in set three. (No Coin Toss.)
2. Players do not line up at the end lines before the match. Players go straight to the court and play.
3. Players will shake hands after the match is over.
4. Teams next up in playing must be on deck half way through the last set of the match.

12'S PLAYING MODIFICATIONS:

1. A coach or parent must referee. Unless the AJV has assigned an official.
2. Teams in parenthesis (the officiating team) must provide a score flipper and scoresheet ticker when an AJV referee is officiating.
3. No line judges, scorekeepers or libero trackers will be used.
 - a. Exception: If officials are officiating from floor level, teams in parenthesis must also provide line judges.
4. Teams shall provide a volleyball-lite for play.
5. Each server shall be allowed three consecutive serving points during a term of service. After the third serving point the opponents shall be awarded the ball to serve.
6. The serving line will be measured 24 feet from mid-court. There is no service fault.
7. The net height will be 7.
8. Substitution Procedure:
 - a. The coach must enter the substitution zone with player(s) substituting. The referee will recognize the substitution when players and substitute(s) are in the substitution zone.
 - b. The substitution zone is the area on your side of the court between the net and the 10' line.
 - c. Substitutions may either be by player position or rotation, but not both.
